How the 26th World Scout Jamboree Planning Team is Streamlining Planning and Risk Management with WeTrack

The Customer

The 26th World Scout Jamboree is one of the largest global youth events, gathering around 40,000 participants aged 14 to 18 from 176 countries. Held every four years, this massive outdoor event brings together young people for global dialogue. Scheduled to take place in Poland in 2027, it will be the first Jamboree held in Central Europe since 1933. The event is run entirely by volunteers, with 450 members of the Jamboree planning team working alongside thousands of international service team (IST) volunteers. Over 12 days, scouts will participate in educational activities and adventure sports, all while living together in a 300-hectare temporary "town" in northern Poland. This temporary "town" will feature everything from medical and security services to food provisions and waste management, making it a complex logistical challenge.

The Challenge

Organising an event of this scale presents numerous challenges, particularly in coordinating thousands of participants and volunteers from around the globe. Key challenges included:

1. Global Coordination: The event planning involves volunteers from more than 45 countries, creating complexity in communication and planning.

"We are working with volunteers from more than 45 countries, and having clear coordination and communication is absolutely crucial for us."

2. Risk and Incident Management: With thousands of attendees, including young participants, most of which will be aged 14 to 18, managing safety, security, and potential risks is a top priority.

"We are effectively building a small town for over 40,000 people. Every part of this temporary town — from medical services to transport—must be managed with precision to ensure everyone's safety."

- **3.** Centralising Information: With over 22 departments involved, having a single system to centralise information for all stakeholders is critical.
- **4. Tracking Sustainability Efforts:** As champions of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), the Jamboree needed tools to track and document their sustainability initiatives.
- 5. **Volunteer-Based Operations:** As the event is volunteer-driven, it required a platform that was easy to use and accessible to many.

The Solution

The organising committee selected WeTrack for its comprehensive project management and risk management features.
